As such, the questions in the poster may be a good discussion starter for you.

How can we keep every day positive? We can ask ourselves ... What did I learn? What did I share with others? Who was part of my life today? During the day, you could use some of the questions in this chart to 'check in' with your child. It is great to share some humour with those around you, even though so many things are tough. The simple things help to get us through.

You have made it through the fifth week of remote learning! And next week, there's a Wellbeing Day built into the program!

What made you think hard today?	How will you challenge yourself today?	What can you learn from this experience or mistake?
What would you do differently next time to make things work better?	What else do you want to learn?	What strategy can you try?
Who can you ask for honest feedback?	Did you work as hard as you could have?	If it was too easy, how can you make it more challenging?
Did you hold yourself to high expectations or did you accept "good enough"?	Did you ask for help if you needed it?	What can you do to manage distractions?
Have you reviewed your work or logic for errors or flaws?	Are you proud of the end result? Why or why not?	What's the next challenge to tackle?

When Jesus asked the disciples who they thought he was, Peter answered that Jesus was the Christ, the Son of God. 


